1. 2. Discuss was the need for timelier and better maintenance at Freedom Park. Jim Bunkleman was present, representing the local Veterans, and gave ideas to help us improve grounds. This includes having the landscape trimmed, as well as the weeds sprayed, plants potted or planted. Attempting to get a few outside bids for lawn maintenance and weed control.
3. Continued discussion on replacement of village holiday lights and decorations. Going to ask Village Board to reallocate money for 2016 park programming to holiday lights.
4. Continued discussions on park programming and park rentals, members are going to get ideas from surrounding areas regarding conditional use permits, alcoholic beverages, shelter vs non shelter costs and sizes. Juech and Village Administrator/Clerk Goeckner are working with the local YMCA to develop some programming plans to bring back to Parks Committee in the next few months.
