

Minutes of the Village of Newburg Parks Commission

August 10, 2016 at 6:30p.m., Village Hall

The meeting of the Village of Newburg Parks Commission for Wednesday, August 10, 2016 was called to order. Roll Call of Parks Commission Members was taken with members Gramoll, Monday, Zorn, Baumann, and Juech as well as DPW Superintendent Paul Becker and Village Administrator/Clerk Goeckner present.

Minutes

A motion was made by Monday, seconded by Bauman to approve the minutes of July 13, 2016 meeting, pending any additions or corrections. Motion passed 5-0.

New Business

Unfinished Business

1. Discussion on maintenance and weed control at village parks and possible outsourcing. Local vendors have been contracted and proposals received. The village will proceed with providing weed control and Doc Weber Park, Falkner Park, and Freedom Park. The mowing will not be subcontracted out due to the higher cost versus village staff.
2. Status update on improvements to Freedom Park. Flowers have been planted and are currently being maintained by volunteers.
3. Discussion on funding and purchase of holiday lights and decorations. The village will be allocating \$5,000 for the purchase of these lights and decorations. LED lights will be used. A small sub-committee will handle the decision of type of decorations. Mr. Becker has put together a map showing the location of street light poles with electricity available for the lights.
4. Discussion on possible park programming in conjunction with the YMCA. Commission Chair Juech reviewed the progress she has made with recent meetings with the local YMCA staff and shared a couple of examples of possible programs. Her next step is to meet with representatives from St John's Lutheran Church.
5. Status update on the cleaning of the Falkner Park underpass walkway. Yet to be cleaned. Becker is authorized to purchase a water storage tank for the back of the truck to use as a water source for a pressure washer. Becker is directed to proceed.
6. Status update on the tennis court crack fill. Partially complete, staff ran out of the fill.

Adjournment

A motion was made by Committee Member Bauman, seconded by Zorn to adjourn the meeting. Motion passed 5-0.
