Sealed bids will be received by the Village Clerk until 10:00 a.m. Central time on Thursday, April 20, 2017 at the Village of Newburg, 614 Main Street, P.O. Box 50, Newburg, WI 53060.

Bids submitted after this time will not be accepted. Bids will be opened and publicly read aloud immediately after specified closing time. Interested parties are invited to attend.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The project involves 2.47 miles of asphalt pavement restoration for local residential roadways. Pavement joint sealants will be applied, prior to any pavement restoration, for all cracks greater than 1/4 inch in width. Once the specified asphalt pavement restoration has been applied, pavement marking will be refreshed at existing locations. The locations for specific applications of asphalt pavement restoration are indicated below:

- A. Slurry Seal Treatment - See attached map (Figure #1) for visual representation.
 - a. Bellvue Court (Connie Drive to cul-de-sac)
 - b. Connie Drive (Termini to Enge Drive)
 - c. Dove Court (Pheasant Lane to cul-de-sac)
 - d. Diane Drive (Termini to Enge Drive)
 - e. Enge Drive (Termini to Hickory Road)
 - f. Hickory Road (CTH MY/Main Street to Municipal Drive/Village limits)
 - g. Northvue Court (Connie Drive to cul-de-sac)
 - h. Pheasant Lane (Shady Lane Road to Village limits)
 - i. Quail Court (Pheasant Lane to cul-de-sac)
 - j. Shady Lane Road (CTH MY/Main Street to Village limits)

- B. GSB-88 Treatment – See attached map (Figure #1) for visual representation:
 - a. Bellvue Court (cul-de-sac only)
 - b. Dove Court (cul-de-sac only)

- c. Northvue Court (cul-de-sac only)

BID SECURITY:

Bids shall be accompanied by Bid Security made payable to Owner in an amount of five percent of Bidder's maximum Bid Price in the form of a Bid Bond, certified check, or cashier's check.

If the successful bidder fails to execute the contract and furnish Payment and Performance Bonds within 15 days after the award, the Check or Bid Bond shall be forfeited to the Village of Newburg as liquidated damages per Wisconsin Statutes.

No bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days after the opening date.

PUBLIC CONTRACT REQUIREMENTS:

Bidder will be required to submit a full and complete statement of financial ability, equipment, experience in work prescribed in documents and other items required for protection and welfare of the public, in accordance with S.66.0901, Wisconsin Statutes, and shall be received by Owner not less than 5 days prior

to the time set for the opening of bids.

Procurement of the work and the award of the contract will be in accordance with the provisions of the State of Wisconsin Statutes S.61.55, S.66.0901, and S.779.16.

CONTRACTOR’S QUALIFICATION STATEMENT:

Bidder shall be required to submit a Qualification Statement to Owner with its bid. Owner's decision as to qualification of Bidder shall be final.

Contractor shall complete and submit Section 00 45 13 - Contractor’s Qualification Statement bound within this manual.

RIGHT TO REJECT BIDS:

Owner reserves the right to reject any and all Bids, to waive any and all informalities not involving price, time, or changes in the Work, and the right to disregard all non-conforming, non-responsive, unbalanced, or conditional Bids.

CONTRACT SECURITY:
