

Minutes
Board of Review
Village of Newburg
Washington and Ozaukee Counties
May 31, 2016

Board of Review was called to order at 6:00 P.M. May 31, 2016. This meeting has been given public notice in accordance with Section 19.83 and 19.84, Wis. Stats, in such form that will apprise the general public and news media of subject matter that is intended for consideration and action. Roll was taken and those present were Board President Heili, Trustee Strohmeyer, and Village Administrator/Clerk Goeckner; attending later in the meeting Trustees Juech and Baumann; absent Trustee Camlin. Also present Assessor Carlson.

A motion was made by Heili and seconded by Goeckner to nominate Heili as Chairman of the Board of Review. Motion passed, 3 - 0.

A motion was made by Goeckner, seconded by Heili to nominate Strohmeyer as Vice-Chair of the Board of Review. Motion passed 3 – 0.

Goeckner verified that the State mandatory training requirement of at least one Board member has been fulfilled by Juech and Baumann neither of whom are currently present at this meeting. (both were in attendance prior to the meeting's adjournment)

A motion was made by Goeckner, seconded by Strohmeyer to approve the Board of Review minutes from May 26, 2015. Motion passed, 3 - 0.

Enter Juech.

Heili reviewed with the Board the basic Board the Review checklist as to the process and how the meeting is handled. There were no requests by any property owners to attend tonight's Board of Review hearing. Assessor Carlson presented the final assessment rolls for both Counties to the Board of Review which is a statement of both real estate and property assessments. Both Goeckner and Carlson continued to explain and give examples of the process and how changes made affect the levy and community.

Enter Baumann.

Goeckner led discussion as to allowing testimony by telephone or sworn written statements. Noted were possible pros and cons. A motion was made by Heili, seconded by Strohmeyer to deny allowing testimony by telephone or sworn written statements. Motion passed 5 – 0.

Goeckner led discussion on allowing for waiver of Board of Review hearing requests. Noted were possible pros and cons. A motion was made by Juech, seconded by Strohmeyer to deny allowing waiver of Board of Review hearing request. Motion passed 5 – 0.

No one appeared before the Board to provide any testimony or file any objections.

Board members reviewed both the Ozaukee and Washington County 2016 Final Roll/Assessment books for possible discrepancies. Several possible assessment value issues were discussed.

Motion was made by Heili and seconded by Strohmeyer to close the hearing at 8:00 P.M.
Motion passed, 5 - 0.
