

Minutes of the Village of Newburg Parks Commission

March 8, 2017 at 6:30p.m., Village Hall

The meeting of the Village of Newburg Parks Commission for Wednesday, March 8, 2017 was called to order. Roll Call of Parks Commission Members was taken with members Roger Zorn, Amy Juech, Mary Monday, Lisa Gramoll as well as DPW Superintendent Waech present. Absent was Ann Baumann.

Minutes

A motion was made by Mary Monday and seconded by Roger Zorn to approve the minutes of November 9, 2016 meeting, pending any additions or corrections. Motion passed 4-0.

Old Business

1. Discussed snow removal at entrance and paths at Falkner Park, suggested leaving alone because of additional upkeep, cost to maintain and insurance questioning liability.
2. Introduced new DPW Superintendent Waech to Parks Commission.
3. Sending out quote requests to fix or resurface tennis court at Doc Weber Park.
4. Talked about planting trees at Grotelueschen President's Park. Waech was going to look into a few programs. A decision will need to be made as to the type of trees and their location.
5. Porta-potty will be delivered at same cost as last year to Doc Weber Park from May to October.
6. Superintendent Waech is going to look at ground at Doc Weber Park. He will then going to get quotes to maintain and or update ball diamond and volleyball court.

Unfinished Business

1. Installation of lighting and outlets on poles at Doc Weber Park after April 1st.
2. Surveying for correct ownership and creating a maintenance plan at Freedom Park as well as discussion on adding planters and flowers at parks request.
3. Holiday lights were purchased at a 30% discount and will receive this summer for use this winter.
4. Still working with YMCA and St. Johns for use of buildings and community programs. Amy Juech and Rick Goeckner are meeting with YMCA daycare facility in Newburg to see what other program would be beneficial for our community.

A motion was made by Committee Member Lisa Gramoll and seconded by Mary Monday to adjourn the meeting. Motion passed 4-0.
