Building Inspections

Permits are required for all building, plumbing, electrical, and HVAC work. This includes sheds, pools, fences, roofing, driveways, sewer connections, etc. This list is not all-inclusive.

Brush Collection

Pick up is the **LAST** Saturday of the month from April through October, curbside only, cut end street-side. Set out by 7:00 A.M. Material must be less than 4 inches in diameter and 6 ft. in length. Brush/tree trimmings only.

Recycling

2nd & 4th Saturday each month 9:00 A.M. to 12:00 at Newburg Maintenance Building 3590 Municipal Drive, except for weekends with legal holidays: such as Thanksgiving and Christmas. 2018 E-Waste day May 12th.

Electric and Gas

Sanitary Sewer

Municipal provided service - sign up for new or transfer of account at Village Hall. Invoices are mailed to the property owner quarterly. Pay bill at: Village Hall, inside during regular office hours or outside night drop after hours. Make checks payable to: Newburg Sanitary. Credit card payments now accepted with additional fee.

Snow Removal

The owner, occupant or person in charge of each and every building or structure or unoccupied lot in the Village fronting or abutting any street shall clean, or cause to be cleaned, the sidewalk in front of or adjoining each such building or unoccupied lot of snow or ice to the width of such sidewalk within 24 hours after the cessation of a snowstorm. When the ice has formed on any sidewalk so that it cannot be immediately removed, the persons herein referred to shall keep the same sprinkled with salt, ashes, sawdust or sand. For a complete copy of the Newburg snow removal regulations, contact Village Hall.

Trash Collection

Service is provided by Advanced Disposal (800)387-0949 through the Village. Roadside Cart System – 2 carts, 1 for trash, 1 for recycling. Trash pick-up is weekly on Friday, recycle pick-up is every other week on Friday (*with Saturday pick-ups during holiday or special event weeks*). See calendar available at Village Hall.
