

THE VILLAGE OF NEWBURG SNOW REMOVAL & ICE CONTROL PRACTICES

The Village of Newburg has a part-time snow plow staff. They maintain 6.82 miles of Village roads. The key elements of our plan are as follows:

- 4 routes
- 3 pieces of equipment (John Deere Loader for plowing streets, a tandem Int dump truck with salter & a F550 truck for plowing parking lots & salting)

The streets are plowed in this order of priority:

- 1) Major arterial routes (the downtown area, also including W Main St out to County Road M)
- 2) Major collector streets
- 3) Local residential streets
- 4) Cul-de-sacs, dead-ends, & parking lots/parking stalls

Please understand that the major arterial routes will get priority over all other routes during a snowfall that may last over many hours. The Village of Newburg does NOT maintain a “bare pavement” policy for all streets. This is for economic & environmental reasons. During snowfall events, we may need to plow your street more than once to clean it completely. Unfortunately this may result in the snowplow filling your driveway with snow after you have already opened it.
