## **Newburg Seeks Applicants for Trustee Position**

Newburg, WI – The Village of Newburg is accepting letters of interest from residents interested in serving as a member of the Board of Trustees. Trustee Chris Stangel has resigned from his position leaving a vacancy on the seven member board.

The topic of appointing someone to fill the vacancy will be scheduled for consideration at the September 12, 2019 meeting of the Board of Trustees. The board may vote on an appointment at that time, or may delay a decision until a future meeting date. The board may also choose not to make an appointment and to instead allow a new Trustee to be selected by voters in the April 2020 election.

Trustee is a part-time position paying a salary of \$1,450 per year. The Village Board is made up of six Trustees and the Village President, who meet either as the Board or as a Committee of the Whole in the evenings of the second and fourth Thursdays of each month. Special meetings may be required throughout the year depending on the village's projects and concerns.

Village residents interested in being considered for the position are encouraged to deliver a letter of interest by email to [clerk@village.newburg.wi.us](mailto:clerk@village.newburg.wi.us) or by mail or hand delivery to Village Hall, 620 W Main St., P.O. Box 50, Newburg, WI 53060-0050. The clerk will collect all documents received for presentation to the Board of Trustees.

Those wishing to be considered at the first available opportunity for a vote should submit interest by 9am on Thursday, September 5, 2019.
